Participants will receive training to reach older adults through group presentations and home visits.

- excited to help older adults reduce injuries from fires and falls.
- committed to building a community outreach program.
- enthusiastic about strengthening partnerships to support older adults.

Scholarship award

Each *Remembering When* scholarship is valued at more than \$4,000 and includes:

- a training workshop in San Antonio from November 14–16, 2016 for each team.
- airfare to and from San Antonio & shuttle transportation to and from the hotel.
- lodging at the Drury Plaza Hotel San Antonio Riverwalk on November 14 and 15, 2016.
- a networking reception on the evening of November 14, 2016.
- breakfast, lunch, and snacks throughout the training.
- ongoing support from NFPA for program implementation.
